## MATHS



We will be learning to count money in pence and pounds. We will be making amounts and comparing amounts of money.



We will then move onto multiplication and division. We will recognise, make and add equal groups, introduce the multiplication symbol (x) and calculate multiplication number sentences.

We will make and use arrays to help us with our calculations. In addition, we will revisit grouping and sharing before moving onto the two times table.



## ENGLISH



The children will continue to use a range of fiction and non-fiction texts as a writing stimulus. They will continue to develop the use of expanded noun phrases and conjunctions in their writing. The children will write a diary recount based on the story 'Katie in London'. They will be expected to write using their best handwriting every time they write.

## SCIENCE



**What material would make the best bucket?**

In science we will be finding out about the importance of picking the correct material to make objects.



## RE



**Islam**

**Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?**

The children will learn what the basic beliefs of Muslims are and learn how stories are important in the Islam religion. They will explore the 5 pillars of Islam and learn how Muslims pray.

## PSHE



**Drugs, alcohol and tobacco – Medicines and Me**

The children will learn about why we might need to take medicines, where adults can get medicines from and how to keep themselves safe around medicines. We will look specifically at medicines used to treat medical conditions such as asthma.

## ART



**Craft and Design: Woven Wonders!**

The children will learn and practise a range of skills including choosing, measuring, arranging and fixing materials. They will explore plaiting, threading and knotting techniques and learn how to weave. They will combine these techniques to create a piece of woven artwork.

## PE



**PE days for both classes – Tuesday**

- There will be two PE lessons per week so please ensure PE kits are in for those days and are fully named.
- This half term we will be focusing on ball skills (hands) and health and well-being.



## HISTORY

**Was the Great Fire of London really a disaster?**

The children will be learning all about the Great Fire of London. They will learn about when the fire started, where the fire began and how the fire started. They will read from Samuel Pepys diary and find out how people tried to put the fire out. The children will also learn about how things changed in London afterwards as a result of the fire.

- Please read as much as possible with your child. Try and aim to read with your child every day, for at least 10 minutes and make a short note in their reading diary.
- It is also important that you read to your child as much as possible too!
- **Home learning will be given out every Friday and should be returned by the following Wednesday.**
