MATHS



This half term we will be focusing on working with fractions, decimals and percentages.

Children will learn how to:

- Convert between the different forms and recall their equivalences.
- Add and subtract fractions, including those greater than 1.
- Multiply and divide fractions.
- Multiply decimals.
- Calculate percentages of amounts.



ENGLISH



During our English sessions this half term, we will be writing for a range of audiences and purposes. We will focus on writing a biography about Queen Victoria and a persuasive letter to Queen Victoria, persuading her to change the laws regarding working children during the Victorian era.

We are working on building our grammar knowledge and spelling skills through our English lessons.

SCIENCE



Electricity

Throughout this unit, the children will explore what makes a complete circuit, exploring a range of different electrical components. Children will learn the symbol for each component and use these to draw circuit diagrams. Children will also investigate how different voltages can affect electrical components.
