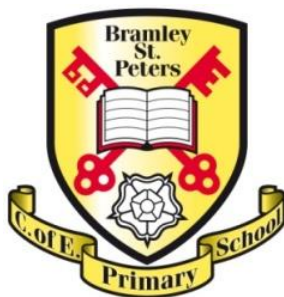

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you to share the report of our recent Ofsted inspection now it has been published.

We are delighted to inform you that we are now graded as a 'good' school, with good in all areas. This is obviously extremely pleasing for the staff team and I and it is testament to the hard work that has gone into making improvements within the school.

Our vision statement says we are 'Journeying together with God'. We have been on quite a journey in the past few years as a school. Since the last Ofsted inspection, and before that too, we have worked hard to improve many areas of school. The inspectors recognised this hard work and the positive impact it has had on our provision.

The inspection itself was an intense affair with five subjects receiving a 'deep dive' into them. These were maths, reading, science, geography and PSHE. The leaders of these subjects worked incredibly hard in the inspection to share the work they have done and the difference it has made.

Our journey continues and the identified areas for improvement were already known to us. Our work around the curriculum was hindered by covid but is back on track. We are now moving on from the subjects we have developed, to the next group of subjects. We will be evaluating the quality of provision within these subjects and Senior Leaders will be supporting the subject leaders to make necessary changes so they can have a greater impact.

The few inconsistencies, that were noted by Ofsted, in the quality of teaching in some classes are already being dealt with. Staff are being supported in order to make the necessary improvements within the quality of provision.
