Literacy

We will be reading lots of stories linked to our topic, 'Once Upon a Time'. We will be retelling some of the stories and writing our own stories about dragons.



In Little Wandle phonics we will be:

- Reading and writing longer words.
- Words ending in -es, -ing, -ed, -er, -est.
- Reading Phase 4 tricky words: **said, so have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out today.**
- Secure spelling tricky words taught so far.
