MATHS



- We will be using White Rose Maths planning for our learning. Our main focus this half term will be **place value within 10**. The children will be doing lots of counting forwards and backwards, sorting, matching and comparing objects and numbers, and using mathematical language such as; more, less, same, equivalent, equals, fewer and greater.
- The children will also be introduced to the number line.
- They will continue to use concrete materials such as Numicon, ten frames, counters and cubes to support with mathematical thinking, reasoning and problem solving.



ENGLISH



- We will continue to use Little Wandle to recap Phase 2, 3 and 4 sounds and tricky words. Then we will begin to learn our Phase 5 sounds and tricky words.
- The children will read 3 times per week in small reading groups.
- We will be reading Odd Dog Out, Something Else and Supertato. We will use these books to write simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops, also focusing on letter formation and handwriting.
- The children will learn and perform the poem 'When the Wind Blows' by John Foster. They will also use musical instruments to add effect.
- The children will go on an Autumn sensory walk to support them with writing their own Autumn sensory list poem.

SCIENCE



Animals Including Humans

Who am I?

- The children will identify, name, label and draw basic parts of the human body.
- They will also be learning about the 5 senses (sight, hearing, smell, taste and touch) and will carry out experiments using them.

RE



Belonging

The children will describe why loving others is important in lots of communities.

They will give an account of what happens during a Jewish welcoming ceremony and identify two ways people show they love each other during a Christian wedding.

ONE LIFE



PSHE

One life

The children will learn about their physical fitness, social fitness and mental fitness. They will be learning about how everyone is unique, everyone has an inner critique and an inner cheerleader. We will be thinking about family and friendships and how we can show kindness.

DT



- The children will be finding out about fruits and vegetables and then design and make their own smoothie.

PE



Monday: Outdoor PE - we will be focusing on jumping.

Wednesday: Indoor PE - we will be focusing on ball skills.

GEOGRAPHY



Geography - Where do I live?

- The children will explore the school grounds and local area, identifying human and physical features, and understanding their similarities and differences.
- They will also be using compasses and maps to follow directions both inside and outside of school.

COMPUTING



- The children will be learning how to log on safely to the computers and how to use Purple Mash.

- Please read as much as possible with your child. Try and aim to read with your child daily for at least 10 minutes and make a short note in their reading diary.
