Our topic this half term is: **Bears**

Would you like to go on a bear hunt?

Children will listen to different stories about bears and they will retell the stories they hear.

The children will learn simple facts about bears, including where they live and what they eat.

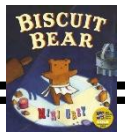
We will look at teddy bears including some very old bears and compare them to the children's own teddy bears.

We will work creatively thinking about bears eg using paint, collage materials, make paper plate bear faces and bake bear biscuits and decorate them.

The children will be able to build chairs and beds for the three bears (Goldilocks and the Three Bears) and go on bear hunts in the classroom and in the Outdoor Area; keeping a record of the bears they find thinking about different sizes and colours.

We will also have a 'Teddy Bears' Picnic' together, making simple sandwiches and having fun with our teddy bears.

### Maths

In maths we will explore capacity and weight whilst baking biscuit bears.

We will also use a selection of bowls and porridge oats to explore quantity. We will find out which bowl holds the most/least porridge? We will learn the vocabulary of capacity such as full, half-full, empty and overflowing.

We will measure our teddy bears using cubes and other objects and order objects by size.

We are going to create repeating patterns using compare bears or pictures from a bear story.

We will go on a 'Bear Hunt' in the classroom and in the Outdoor Area we will be looking for bears of different colours and sizes.

We will of course keep counting and learning new number songs.

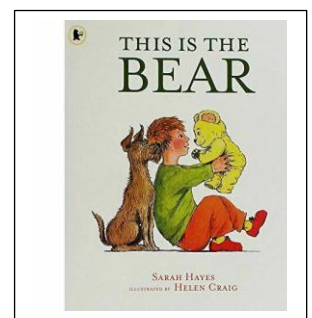
### Literacy

We will encourage the children to ask questions and retell the stories when they are confident.

We will continue to practise drawing, making marks using different tools and writing our names.
