Dear parents/carers,

We are now in the final half term of this academic year. There is lots planned this half term and we are starting to look at our transition to the next academic year. We are looking at staffing and where children will go as they move to the next year group. Children will then spend time later in the half term meeting their new class and staff and spending time in their new classroom.

This half term we have a number of events—the last few parental engagement events (see p3 of the newsletter), a number of sporting events including our own Sports Day, a number of trips and visitors and an opportunity for you to meet your child's new class teacher for the next academic year.

Transition for our Y6 pupils has begun with visits from some high schools taking place and transition days at the high schools coming up. We recognise it can be an unsettling time for some pupils and there is extra support being put in place for them.
