Dear parents/carers,

This is one of our busiest half terms, as one academic year draws to a close but with planning already starting for the next academic year. Please look carefully at the dates on the website and on the next page of this newsletter.

Each class leads a collective worship during the school year. Our theme for this half term is wisdom and we are looking forward to our final few classes leading collective worship and sharing their 'pearls of wisdom' with us.

We have already had some family events. Our Family Breakfasts are coming to a close for the year with Y6 having their event and Reception's due on Wednesday 2nd July. It was also lovely to see the dining room full for our Reception afternoon tea event for grandparents.

Our Y5 classes have been linked with two different schools this year. 5HC have linked with Otley All Saints and 5LS with Barkston Ash. They have been linking in different ways throughout the year and they are now culminating the experience with visits to each of the schools. We have been welcomed to both schools and the reciprocal visits are due to happen in the next couple of weeks.

Our Y1 and Y4 pupils have been undertaking their external assessments with Y1 pupils having their Phonics Screening Check and Y4 pupils having their Multiplication Tables Check in the past couple of weeks. Results will be passed to parents/carers when the end of year reports are distributed.

We are expecting the warm weather to continue with temperatures expected to rise further in the coming days. Please do remember to ensure you are following our sun safety guidelines for yourselves and your children. Children should come to school with a hat and suncream already applied, this is especially important on sunny days. They should also keep hydrated so a named water bottle is essential in school too.

Our transition programme for our new pupils joining us in Reception in September has started. Stay and play sessions are booked in for the coming weeks where children will be able to visit the setting.

Transition for our Y6 pupils has begun with visits from some high schools taking place and transition days at the high schools coming up. We recognise it can be an unsettling time for some pupils and there is extra support being put in place for them.
