Dear parents/carers,

It is a very busy time of year in school with lots of events happening. We are entering our last two weeks where there will be even more events happening.

Our transition processes are well underway. We are completing visits for the children starting with us in Reception in September, our current pupils have spent time meeting their new staff and being in their new classroom and our Y6 pupils are in the process of undertaking visits to their new high schools.

We have had a lovely Sports Day today with the sun shining down on us. Thank you to all those families who joined us and especially those who participated in the running races! Thank you to Mrs Wilson and the PE team who have organised and delivered today's event.

Y6 have been busy since they finished their SATs! The children led the Summer Fayre, helped coordinate the fun run last week and a group of children attended Junior Warrior. The Summer Fayre raised over £600 and it looks like the fun run has raised around £1500—thank you for your generosity. Thank you to the Y6 team for their organisation of these events, especially Mrs Leonard who led the Summer Fayre. Y6 have a number of events in the last two weeks where they will be able to celebrate their time at BSP.

Reception this week enjoyed exploring the Art Gallery and Leeds City Museum, Y2 have taken part in the annual Skipping Festival at Armley Leisure Centre, BSP were represented well at the Bramley Olympics by our team of children from Y2 to Y6, Otley All Saints have now visited 5HC in their reciprocal visit, the M2 group ran the Bramley Park Run and a team of dancers danced the night away at Leeds Rhinos Dance Spectacular.

To make it easier for parent/carers to communicate with us about attendance, we have set up a new e-mail address. The address is attendance@bsp.leeds.sch.uk

The attendance e-mail can be used to communicate the following:

Type of Absence	Action	Please include
Child is ill	E-mail or call (option 1)	Child's name, class and reason for absence
Hospital or Dental appointment	E-mail or call (option 2)	Child's name, class, time you need to collect and time your child will return to school. If using e-mail please include details of the appointment e.g. e-mail confirmation
Other appointments	E-mail or call (option 2)	Child's name, details of the appointment time, reason for the appointment, time you need to collect and time your child will return to school. If using e-mail please include details of the appointment e.g. e-mail confirmation

We are in the process of moving to a new system in school for our main data point. We are starting to use 'Arbor' as a new system. This has a parent app which we will publicise in due course. We anticipate this will be available for use in September for the start of the new school year.
