Dear parents/carers,

We have arrived at the end of our spring term. It is lovely to see the sun shining, have longer days and warmer weather.

We have had a busy half term with events like our Galley Poetry Award, sport competitions, 'stay and...' parent sessions and classes leading collective worship.

It was lovely to see a number of families attending our Easter services this week in St Peter's Church. Thank you also to all parents/carers who attended their parents' evening appointments this week. We hope you found the information shared useful.

Sadly Mrs Prouse has had her last day in school today. She is moving to a Deputy Head role and we are sorry to see her go. We have appointed a new SENDCO and Mrs Butters will be starting with us after the Easter break. We are also adding to our team of Behaviour Mentors with two new members of staff joining our team after the Easter break too.

After the Easter break we will be starting our new format for Breakfast Club. As an Early Adopter of the Government's new Breakfast Club scheme, we will have two different sections to the new format. The Early Bird Breakfast Club from 7.30-8.45am and the Free Breakfast Club from 8.15-8.45am. The booking system is open for both parts of the provision and should be used to book children on. Numbers for the Free Breakfast Club are limited to start with so please get in early. Children without a booking will not be able to attend.

Our new system for entering school in a morning will be continuing after the Easter break. We have heard feedback and now have families for Y1 and Y2 waiting away from the door. KS2 children will also be able to enter the building from 8.40am. The changes will be reviewed again after Easter, alongside the new Breakfast Club format.

We have been reviewing some of our systems around behaviour management and we have introduced a Golden Ticket system. Each week a child in each class is chosen for a prize. The prizes so far have been an ice cream party and an Easter egg hunt. Each week there is a different focus and an aspect we are looking for, for example following instructions the first time of asking. Congratulations to the children who have won so far.

We hope you all have a restful Easter break and that the sun continues to shine. We look forward to seeing you on Tuesday 22nd April.

Early Bird and Free Breakfast Clubs



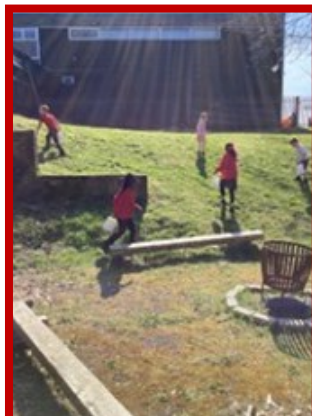

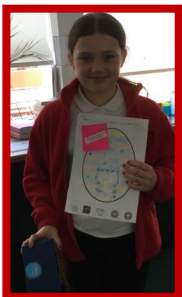

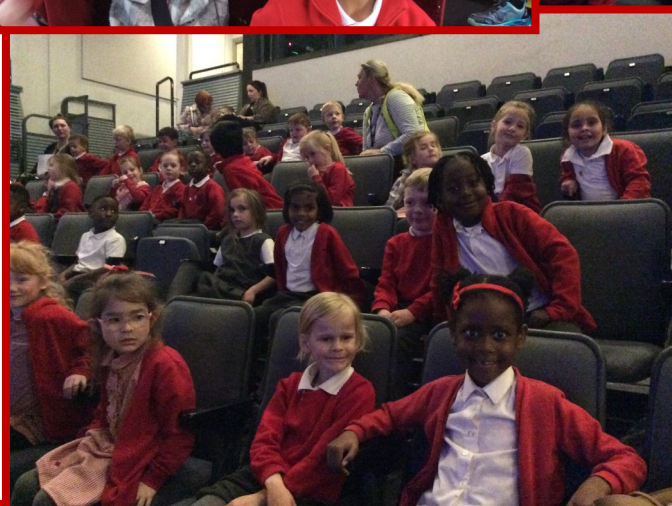
