Dear parents/carers,

Please ensure you are signed up to Seesaw as this is the main way we communicate with our parents/carers. As many family members can be added to Seesaw accounts as needed. We just need an e-mail address to send the invite to and this can be passed on to class staff or the office team.

This half term we have a number of theme days and events in school so please do look carefully at the newsletters (this one and the one from your child's year group) and the school website.

One of the events will be a local charity day on the last day of this half term. This is where we fundraise money for local causes. At the end of January we will then have a vote to determine which charity or charities will be chosen to receive the money we raise.

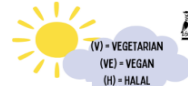
