BSP – Important information for September

SCHOOL MEALS FROM SEPTEMBER

Please be aware that school meals will be increasing to **£2.95** in September at the start of the new school year.

Also children currently in Year 2 will no longer receive universal infant free school meals (UIFSM) when they are in Year 3. Your child will only be eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) if you meet the requirements. You will need to apply. If you need any help please contact the school office.

Morning routine

In September we will be beginning a new morning routine.

Y5/6 children enter by the main back door from 8.40am.

Y3/4 children enter by the door on Hough Lane from 8.40am.

Y1/2 children enter by the side back door from 8.45am.

Reception children are collected from the playground at 8.45am.

Children will then 'meet and greet' their teacher with their chosen 'safe touch'. They will then spend time reflecting, journalling and affirming; getting ready for their day. Details will be shared again in September. Please ensure your child is on time so they do not miss this important part of the day.

Breakfast Club

We will be setting up new club payments for 2025/26 and next year's booking system will go live on 11th August for booking into the clubs for September. We are continuing to reconcile accounts for 2024/25 in order for outstanding debts to be cleared.

The Early Bird Breakfast Club starts at 7.30am and the cost will increase to £4.50 per session.

Bookings must be made in advance on ParentPay.

The Free Breakfast Club opens at 8.15am with last entry at 8.30am. There is no booking required for entry.



After School Club

We will be setting up new club payments for 2025/26 and next year's booking system will go live on 11th August for booking into the club for September.

We are continuing to reconcile accounts for 2024/25 in order for outstanding debts to be cleared.

After School Club charges will be changing.

They will become:

- **Until 4pm (no food) - £5**
- **Until 5pm (with food) - £10**
- **Until 6pm (with food) - £12**

Booking on ParentPay is essential to gain a place.
